<u>Subject</u>: <u>Facilities</u>: <u>Re-transmission of Shipping Bills to DGFT through ICEGATE Portal and filing of Single Unified Multi-Purpose Electronic Bond in Customs-Ekal Anubandh: Reg: Dear Sir (s),</u>

Season's Greetings from The Indian Silk Export Promotion Council (ISEPC)!

ISEPC in its endeavour to facilitate EXIM member exporters taking the various export related issues with the concerned Department in Govt of India and State Governments. We wish to inform the members that we have also flagged the issues of non-transmission of shipping bills to DGFT and requirement of multiple bonds that need to be submitted at different Ports under and for different schemes / benefits. **We are happy to inform the members the followings**:

A) ICEGATE has launched a feature for ICEGATE registered users for re-transmission of shipping bills to DGFT. The step-by-step procedure can be accessed in the ICEGATE Advisory, a copy of the same is attached at **Annex A** with this Circular. The salient features of the same are listed below for ready reference:

- > The Shipping Bill details for re-transmission needs to be filed in "DGFT Retransmission Enquiry", the details will be sent to ICES and then ICES can further process to DGFT for Retransmission.
- ➤ It will take approximately 48 hours to complete the Retransmission Process post submission of SB details.
- ➤ Post Retransmission, Facility to check Retransmission status is available at ICEGATE Portal under "DGFT Retransmission Status Enquiry".

B) CBIC has introduced a project named **"Ekal Anubandh**" vide Circular No. 04/2025-Customs dated 17.02.2025, a copy of which is attached at **Annex B**, wherein trade will be using single All-India Multi-purpose Electronic Bond with end-to-end automation and Submission of Bank Guarantee. The main features of the project are given below:

- ✓ Importer/Exporter can choose the obligations like Provisional Assessment, Export Promotion Schemes, Warehousing under Section 59, MOOWR etc., he intends to undertake in the common bond format and submit at any port of importer's choice electronically at ICEGATE.
- ✓ Option to include additional obligations or additional amount at the later stage is available at ICEGATE
- ✓ Electronic Payment of stamp duty and electronic execution of Bond through integration with National E-Governance Services Limited (NeSL) by affixing electronic signature without any requirement for notary.
- ✓ Online linking End-to-End issued Electronic Bank Guarantee
- ✓ Verification of Bank Guarantee (BG) issued by issuing Bank

In view of the above attached advisory and the custom circular, Members are hereby advised to take benefit of the above functionality.

1. Overview


A feature has been developed for the users, to re-transmit the Shipping Bill (SBs) to DGFT, post login through ICEGATE Portal. Once the user submits the relevant Shipping Bill details in "DGFT Retransmission Enquiry", the details will be sent to ICES and then ICES can further process to DGFT for Retransmission. It will take approximately 48 hours to complete the Retransmission Process post submission of SB details. Post Retransmission, user can also check Retransmission status in "DGFT Retransmission Status Enquiry" through ICEGATE Portal.



2. Submit the SB Details for Re-transmission:


Users to follow the below mentioned steps to "Submit the SB details for Retransmission to DGFT" through ICEGATE Portal.

- Step 2: Click on "Services" widget.




Step 3: Navigate to "Enquiries" and click on "ICEGATE Enquiry Service"






Step 4: Click on "DGFT" enquiry






Step 5: Click on DGFT Retransmission Facility (SB)

- (iv) IEC








3. Retransmission Status:

Users to follow the below steps to check "Retransmission Status" through ICEGATE Portal.


Step 1: Login to ICEGATE portal with respective credentials.

Step 2: Click on "Services" widget.




Step 3: Navigate to "Enquiries" and click on "ICEGATE Enquiry Service".






Step 4: Click on DGFT




Step 5: Click on DGFT Retransmission Status Enquiry.

Upon submission, one of the following statuses will be visible to the user:

- (i) Invalid Shipping Bill No/Date
- (ii) EGM not filed
- (iii) Shipping Bill is provisionally assessed
- (iv) EGM date must be less than today's date
- (v) Shipping Bill already recorded for DGFT transmission today
- (vi) Shipping Bill does not contain LIC/DEPB/DFIA/ROSCTL/DBK Scroll is not generated/ROSCTL claim is present



Dear Sir (s),

Season's Greetings from The Indian Silk Export Promotion Council (ISEPC)!

We wish to inform and as you may be aware, that the disbursal of the drawback was earlier done through ports. However, with effect from 5th June, 2024 as conveyed vide instruction no 15/2024 dated the 29th May 2024, payment of Duty Drawback (DBK) amounts into the exporters' accounts post scroll out, will be facilitated through the Public Finance Management System (PFMS) and will be directly credited to the bank accounts of the exporters.

However, as received quite a few representations of the same not being credited to their accounts post 5th June 2024, despite the scroll being generated. We took up the issues as collated till 15/1/2025 and persuaded the same with the appropriate authorities in CEGATE and to the concerned division in the Drawback department as well.

As conveyed by ICEGATE, the list of drawback amounts credited to exporters' accounts as well as details on pending cases along with the reasons with action to be taken is attached.
